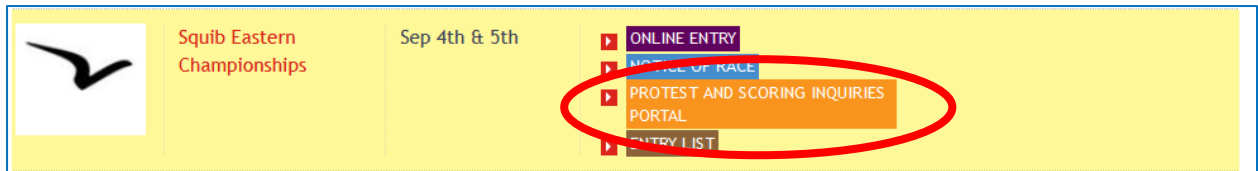


Dear people of the Squibasphere

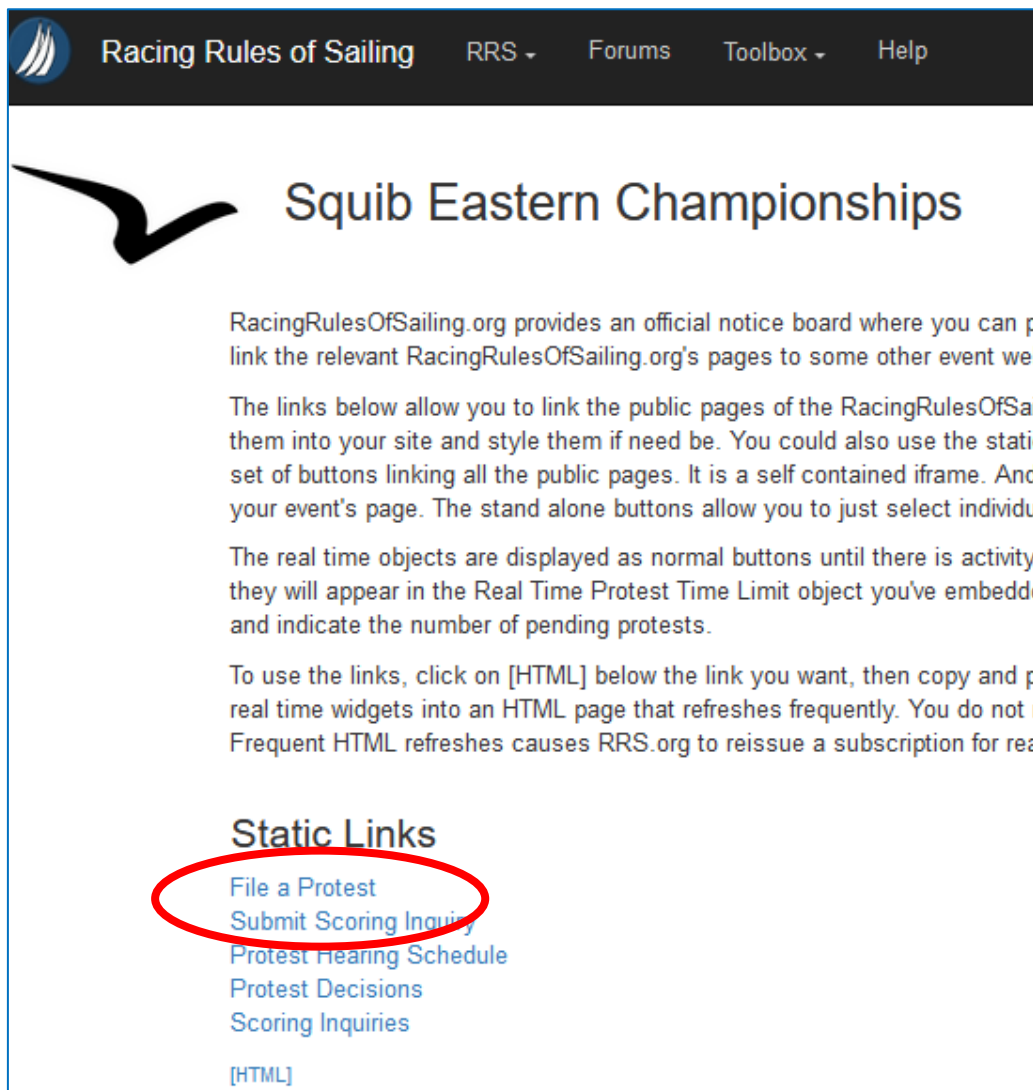

Click “File a Protest” or whichever form is relevant.



When you have completed the form, don't forget to hit **"Save"** at the bottom or it will not be received by the Protest Committee. If you have inputted your email address, you will receive a confirmation email when you submit the form.

- (a) The protestor and protestee
- (b) The incident
- (c) Where and when the incident occurred

You don't need to write a novel!
