# NOTICE OF RACE

The Organising Authority (OA) is Howth Yacht Club.

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1(a).

#### 1 RULES

- 1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) and the Irish Sailing Prescriptions to the Racing Rules of Sailing.
- 1.2 Boats competing shall comply with the Optimist Class Rules.

#### **2 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be posted at https://hyc.ie/open-events before the Regatta.

# 3 COMMUNICATIONS

- 3.1 The online official notice board is located at <a href="https://hyc.ie/open-events">https://hyc.ie/open-events</a>
- 3.2 [DP] From the first warning signal until the end of the last race of the day, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats

# **4 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY**

- 4.1 The Regatta is open to Optimist Main and Regatta fleet competitors.
- 4.2 Boats shall have their full Class allocated sail number displayed in accordance with the Class Rules and RRS.
- 4.3 Entrants may be split into fleets on the day of the race at the discretion of the Race Officer.
- 4.4 Eligible boats should enter using the Brassed Off Cup 2023 entry form online at <a href="https://hyc.ie/open-events">https://hyc.ie/open-events</a>. All entry forms must be signed / consented to by a Parent / Guardian.
- 4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements at the Race Office and pay all fees.

# 5 FEES

5.1 The entry fee is €40.00

# 6 SCHEDULE

- 6.1 Registration will be between 0900 and 1030 Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2023
- 6.2 Main Fleet competitors Briefing will be at 1100 and will be followed by a separate briefing for Regatta Fleet competitors.
- 6.3 First Warning Signal 1200.
- 6.4 Three races are scheduled for the Main Fleet and up to five races may be raced for the Regatta Fleet. No race will be started after 1530, except for postponements, general recalls and abandonment of a race where the first warning signal was made before 1530.

#### 7 VENUE

7.1 The race area will be north of Howth harbour and west of Ireland's Eye.

#### 8 COURSES

8.1 Course types will be set out in the sailing instructions.

# 9 SCORING

- 9.1 Main Fleet: A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores
- 9.2 Regatta Fleet: When four or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

# 10 SUPPORT PERSON VESSELS

10.1 [DP] Except when requested by or agreed with the race committee, coaches and supporters shall not encroach within 100m of any Race Course Area unless requested to assist by an Official Race Committee Boat between the time of the first Warning Signal and the time that the last competitor finishes the race.

# 11 DATA PROTECTION

11.1 By entering the regatta competitors and, where relevant, their parents/guardians accept that they may be photographed and/or videotaped participating in the racing and/or using the Regatta facilities and they consent to the taking of such images and to the use, reuse, publication and republication of such images in any media, in conjunction with the competitor's name or not, without compensation and without the competitor's approval of such images or any use thereof.

# 12 RISK STATEMENT

- 12.1 Rule 3 of the Racing Rules of Sailing states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue racing is hers alone.'

  Sailing is by its nature an unpredictable sport and therefore inherently involves an element of risk. By taking part in the event, each competitor agrees and acknowledges that:
  - (a) They are aware of the inherent element of risk involved in the sport and accept responsibility for the exposure of themselves, their crew and their boat to such inherent risk whilst taking part in the event;
  - (b) They are responsible for the safety of themselves, their crew, their boat and their other property whether afloat or ashore;
  - (c) They accept responsibility for any injury, damage or loss to the extent caused by their own actions or omissions;
  - (d) Their boat is in good order, equipped to sail in the event and they are fit to participate;

- (e) The provision of a race management team, patrol boats and other officials and volunteers by the event organizer does not relieve them of their own responsibilities;
- (f) The provision of patrol boat cover is limited to such assistance, particularly in extreme weather conditions, as can be practically provided in the circumstances;
- (g) It is their responsibility to familiarise themselves with any risks specific to this venue or this event drawn to their attention in any rules and information produced for the venue or event and to attend any safety briefing held for the event.

#### 13 INSURANCE

13.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with adequate, valid, third-party cover with an appropriate extension for racing risks

# 14 PRIZES

14.1 Prizes will be awarded to Main (Senior / Junior) and Regatta fleet sailors. All participants will receive an Easter Egg at the Brassed off cup 2023.

# **15 FURTHER INFORMATION**

- 15.1 Competitors are granted temporary membership of Howth Yacht Club for each race day subject only to the provisions of the Club rules for withdrawing or withholding such membership
