General Information for Competitors

Trailer Storage Information

Road trailers for all dinghies and RIBs cannot be stored at Howth Yacht Club for the duration of the event. The Harbour Master has kindly given use of a space for trailers on the Middle Pier, marked in red on the map below. After unloading at the sailing club, please bring trailers to the dedicated parking down the pier. Trailers are parked at the owners' risk.

Dinghy Pen

Upon arrival in HYC, please park your ILCA dinghy in the dedicated areas as instructed. Each boat is to remain parked in that area for the duration of the event when ashore.

Launching RIBs

RIBs can be launched from the Public Slipway beside the RNLI station (blue box on map below).

Registration

Registration for sailors & support persons will be in the HYC Junior Room (purple on map below) at the times set out in NOR 9.

Support Person Registration

Support boats on the water (Coaches, parents etc) need to register their presence at the Registration desk. There will be a form to fill out, and you will be given a flag to display while afloat (a deposit of €20 applies). Please note your responsibilities as per NoR 16.

Daily Schedule

There will be a daily briefing where weather updates, safety updates, and the leaders bibs will be handed out.

Storing visiting RIBs on Marina

Check in with the Marina Office at HYC to determine where your RIB can be stored on the Marina.

Getting to the club (Car parking, bus, DART)

- Car parking is available for free around the harbour. Please only park in dedicated spots, do not block yellow boxes or access to the RNLI station.
- Bus The H3 Dublin Bus runs past the yacht club from the city centre (Abbey Street Lower).
- DART the DART runs to Howth station, which is 5 minute walk from the club. Please note, the DART service begins later on a Sunday, which may not get you to the club on time for racing.

Navigating waters in Howth harbour and when entering/leaving the harbour

Please note that the harbour is a commercial port, and commercial vessels have right of way in the channel and entering/leaving the harbour. Follow direction from support vessels who may ask you to change course to allow a commercial vessel to navigate.

There will be food and entertainment for competitors when the sailors return to shore each day, details will be posted separately.

The HYC bar and restaurant is available to all competitors and supporters each morning, afternoon and evening.
